Dear colleagues,

One of the purposes of the Strategic Plan is to "consolidate international cooperation with organizations of the United Nations system, States and their education systems, civil society organizations and universities, in order to create synergies to collaborate in the achievement of the 2030 Agenda." To that end, during April I have continued offering guidance to governments and working hard with UNESCO (on the CCNGO and the GPS) and other NGOs, such as the Global Campaign for Education and EDUCO.

Between April 26th and 30th, we advocated for the Global Action Week for Education: One Million Voices, organized by the Global Campaign for Education (https://campaignforeducation.org) with the objective to get financing to ensure inclusive, quality and egalitarian education and promote learning opportunities for all.

I have also met with Right to Education (RTE) in order to articulate and boost the impact of our work. This NGO has recently published a document with UNESCO, called "Right to pre-primary education. A global study", which I strongly recommend everyone to read:

OMEP and RTE are working on the idea to conduct research on the Privatization of Early Childhood Education, so I will be grateful to get any information and studies published on this topic, as well as volunteers that would like to participate in this initiative. As regards the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child, this month Springer published the book Young Children in the World and their Rights, coordinated by Adrijana Višnjić Jevtić, Alicja Sadownik and Ingrid Engdahl, where there are articles written by OMEP colleagues from all over the world. I am proud to have taken part in such a great collective work, which we hope will prove useful to understand the different visions on the CRC, as well as the policies, research and practices in different countries.

About the OMEP Education for Sustainable Development World Project, I would like you to know that OMEP applied for the UNESCO Japan Prize 2021 with the project "Sustainability from the Start: an online ESD Curriculum for Early Childhood Education (ECE)." In February 2021, Lisbeth Gouin, our OMEP representative in Paris, sent us the news about the open call, so I worked on the application for OMEP. The team in charge of the ESD World Project, led by Ingrid Engdahl and Ingrid Pramling, drafted the application form, which was presented on April 28th. Let's cross our fingers and hope that UNESCO grants the Japan Prize 2021 to OMEP!

2. ACTIVITIES IN THE UNITED NATIONS SYSTEM

- → UNESCO / Global Partnership Strategy for Early Childhood. On April 7th, the last comments and inputs on the strategy created by the World President and the OMEP team were sent.
- → UNITED NATIONS FOLLOW-UP ON THE AGENDA 2030 / 2021 Ministerial Declaration from the High-Level Segment of the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) and the High-level Political Forum on Sustainable Development "Sustainable and resilient recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic, that promotes social, economic and environmental aspects of sustainable development." The forum is held annually in July, to follow up on SDG achievements. For several months, the World President has been participating in the NGOs Global Organizing Member Committee. The UN representative Jessica Essary has recently come on board. Guidance was provided for the ministerial declaration and OMEP presented a 500-word statement given its special consultative status before the High-Level Segment at the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC). It is also being considered to participate in a parallel event with other organizations.
