OMEP WORLD ASSEMBLY AND CONFERENCE 2022

During the month of August we returned to activities at the headquarters of the World Presidency. We are closing the process of the Assembly and Conference in Athens, working with the minutes and other documents, and it seems especially important to us that all the committees have access in one way or another to the materials and conclusions.

Three videos were edited that summarize this productive experience so that they can be shared with the members and communities of each National Committee.

WORLD CONGRESS OF ECCE (WCECCE 2022), ORGANIZED BY UNESCO

a) The World Conference in Tashkent, Uzbekistan

OMEP is participating as a member of the **Program Committee**, invited by UNESCO. In the month of August, Adrijana Visnjic (OMEP Regional Vice President for Europe), Lisbeth Gouin (UNESCO Representative) and I will participate in the event in person. In order to share this process, we invite all the national committees to participate in Regional Cafés during the month of October. During them, we will be able to discuss the central themes of the Conference to generate knowledge, share reports and research related to this important event. Each Regional Vice President will be in charge of contacting the countries to organize these meetings, and the World Presidency will participate and attend as always.

- b) Consultancy for the UNESCO Regional Office for Latin America and the Caribbean Within the framework of the regional actions that will conclude at the WCECCE 2022, I have been invited to participate in two actions:
 - Collaborate in the preparation of a regional report on Early Childhood Education and Care (ECCE) in Latin America and the Caribbean (LAC) in the last decade, guaranteeing general conceptual cohesion throughout the report through the technical review of its chapters and write the following sections: Brief Summary, Executive Summary, Introduction, Conclusion and Recommendations.
 - Act as main rapporteur of the Regional Consultation on Early Childhood Care and Education in Latin America and the Caribbean, held on August 30 and 31, and prepare the Final Document of the consultation with the main discussions of the LAC Member States to strengthen policies and international cooperation to support the advancement of ECCE and target 4.2 in the region. The recommendations are structured around the four main themes of the consultation: Legislation, Policy and Governance: Intersectorial Approaches; ECCE financing; quality and inclusion of ECCE

programs; ECCE workforce; SDG 4.2 monitoring capacity by member states and their use of data and evidence in formulating ECCE policies.

It is essential that we strengthen alliances with UNESCO and other international organizations around the world and that OMEP be considered as a specialist in ECCE issues, as well as making early childhood education and care visible as a human right without exclusions.

TRANSFORMING EDUCATION SUMMIT (TES)

It will take place on September 16, 17 and 19 in New York and I have been invited by the Secretary General of the United Nations. In New York, I will meet with the team of representatives to the United Nations, some of whom will participate with me, representing OMEP at the Summit. I thank you all in advance for your commitment and support and I am very hopeful with our future face-to-face work meeting with Jessica Essary, Kimberly Kopko, Maria Pia Belloni, Fernando Salinas Quiroz, and Donna Wright.
